Since these supplies are for a 72-hour kit, always think of the smallest sizes. There are several types of stoves that would be adequate and small enough.

- Block Magnesium Fire Starter

Light

- Flashlight & batteries
- Instant Light Sticks 12 hour (comes in green or yellow)
- Emergency candles Can be used for fuel or light. (I would not have more than one in a 72-hour kit they are quite heavy compared to a flashlight or light sticks.)
